**Binoy Kumar Singh, M.D.**, is Assistant Professor of Internal Medicine, Division of Cardiology at Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons and an interventional cardiologist at the Center for Interventional Vascular Therapy at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital/Columbia University Medical Center.

Prior to joining the Center, Dr. Singh was an attending cardiologist specializing in noninvasive cardiovascular imaging with the Continuum Heart Institute in New York City.

Dr. Singh received a Bachelor of Science degree in Biomedical Engineering at Boston University, and his medical degree from the Medical College of Pennsylvania (MCP). He pursued his residency in internal medicine at MCP, serving as chief medical resident in cardiovascular diseases. He continued there as a cardiology fellow, becoming chief cardiology fellow before going on to pursue a fellowship at St. Luke's-Roosevelt Hospital Center in noninvasive cardiovascular imaging.

He is the recipient of the Outstanding Service Achievement Award and the Outstanding Academic Achievement Award recognizing his accomplishments while he was a chief cardiology fellow at MCP; First Prize Award for Oral Presentation given at the Fourth World Congress of Cardiology and Vascular Ultrasound; and the AACIO Young Investigators Award presented at the 52nd Annual Meeting of the American College of Cardiology.
