

TRAVEL / HOTELS

Hotels in Manhattan are expensive. Columbia University Medical Center has a subway station located inside the center and hence travelling by train is easy and time saving. Newark, New Jersey has several hotels located near the airport and all these hotels have courtesy shuttles which pick you up from airport and drop you in the airport/train station. From Newark, New Jersey transit trains will take approximately 15-20 minutes to reach Pennsylvania (Penn) station, New York City subway station. From Penn station, New York City, it takes approximately 12-15 min in **Express train A** to reach 168th street stop which is located in the Columbia University Medical Centre campus. Flying to Newark, NJ (airport code: **EWR**) is also less expensive (mostly) than flying to New York City airports (LaGuardia & JFK).
