## **II. Surgery Clerkship**

**Bassett students** will be sent an email with the health and travel information that must be completed before the rotation begins, from Ms. Doris Leddy in MH7-307GS, x 59596. Bassett students must also obtain a physical two weeks prior to the beginning of the clerkship. They must attend orientation at Milstein, you will travel up to Bassett the day after orientation, which would be the first Tuesday of the rotation.
